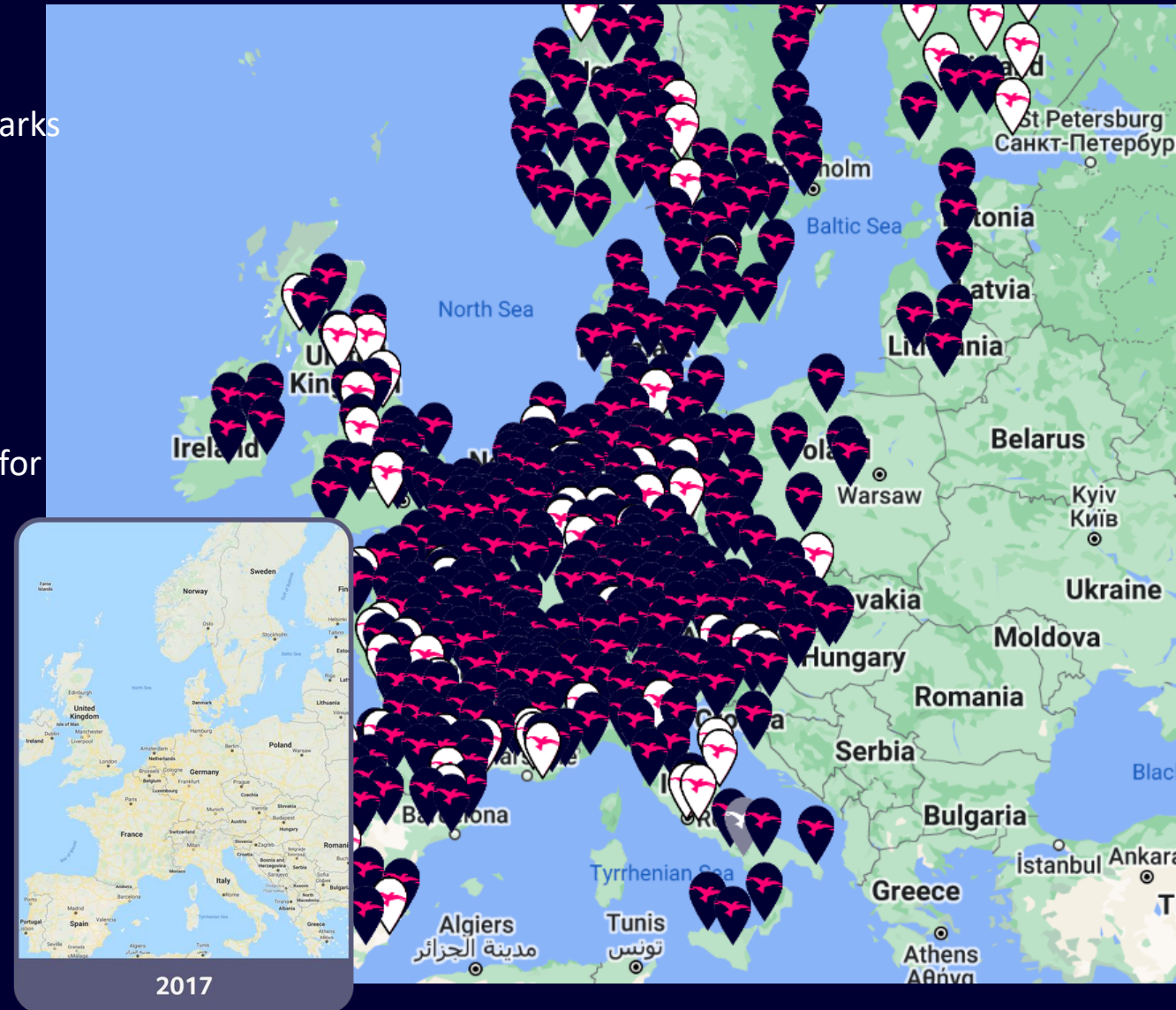

Our goal is simple: Building and operating a high-power charging network for electric vehicles along major highways in Europe.

OUR INFRASTRUCTURE IS EUROPEAN

- IONITY High-Power Charging Network consists of **564** charging parks and **more than 3.000** charging points
- **109** charging parks are currently under construction
- Future-proof technology with **350 kW and 500A** power per charging point
- **“One Europe, One Plug”** – open High Power Charging Network for all EV with CCS along European motorways
- Customer friendly and uniform interfaces, including fully integrated **Plug and Charge**
- High availability with reliable **24/7 customer service** in **7 languages**
- **100% renewable energy** to allow emission free driving

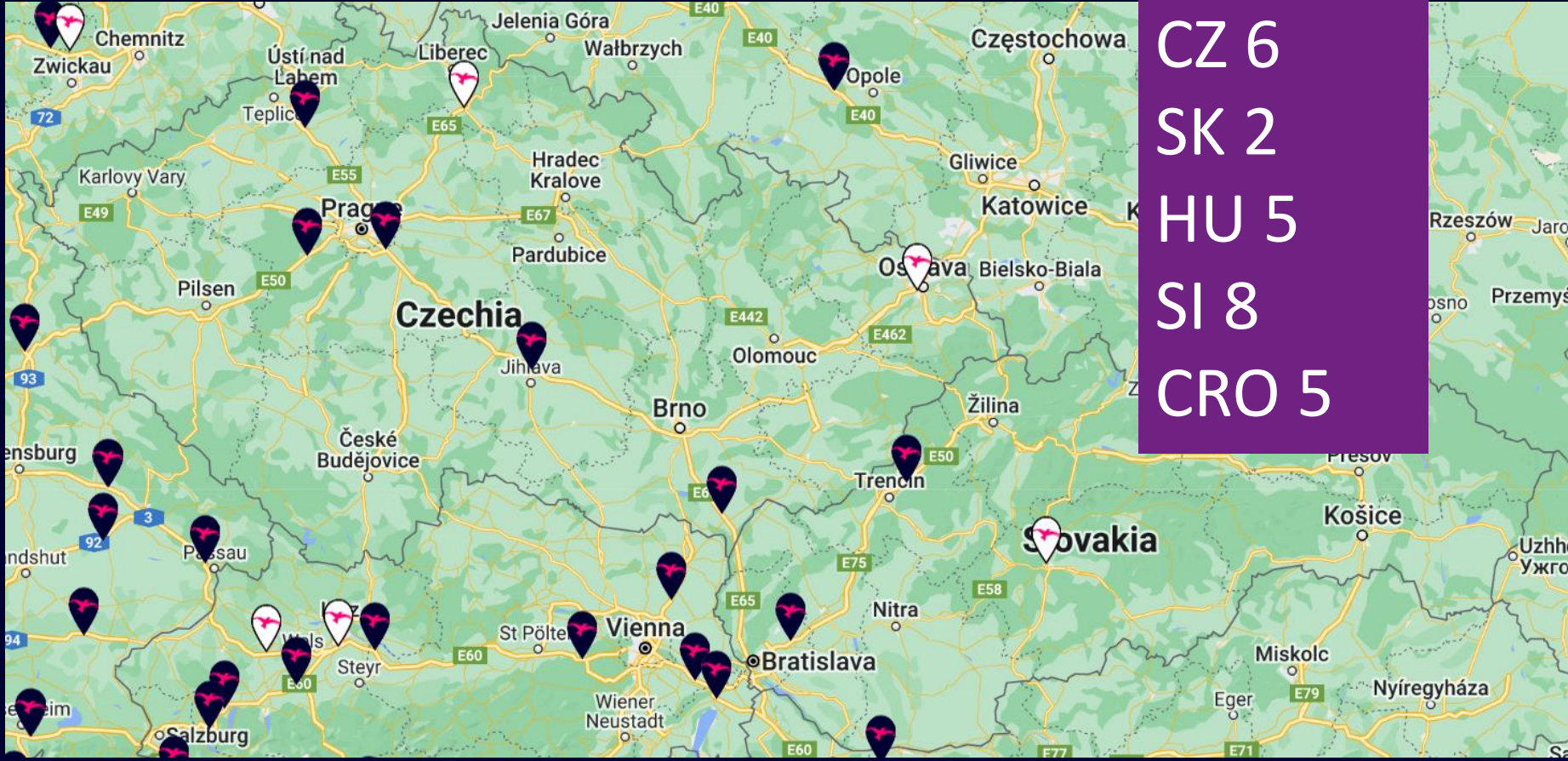
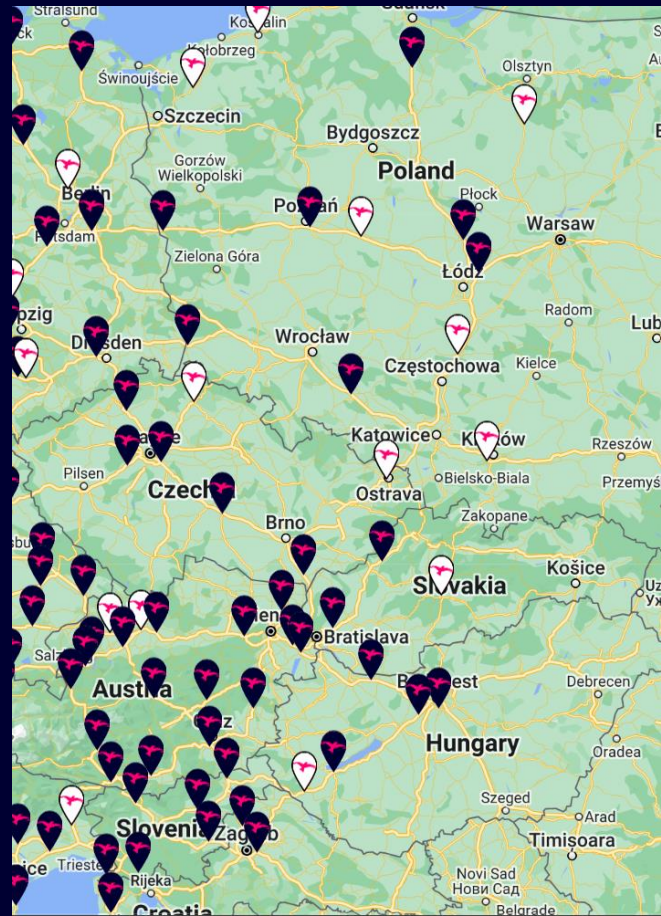

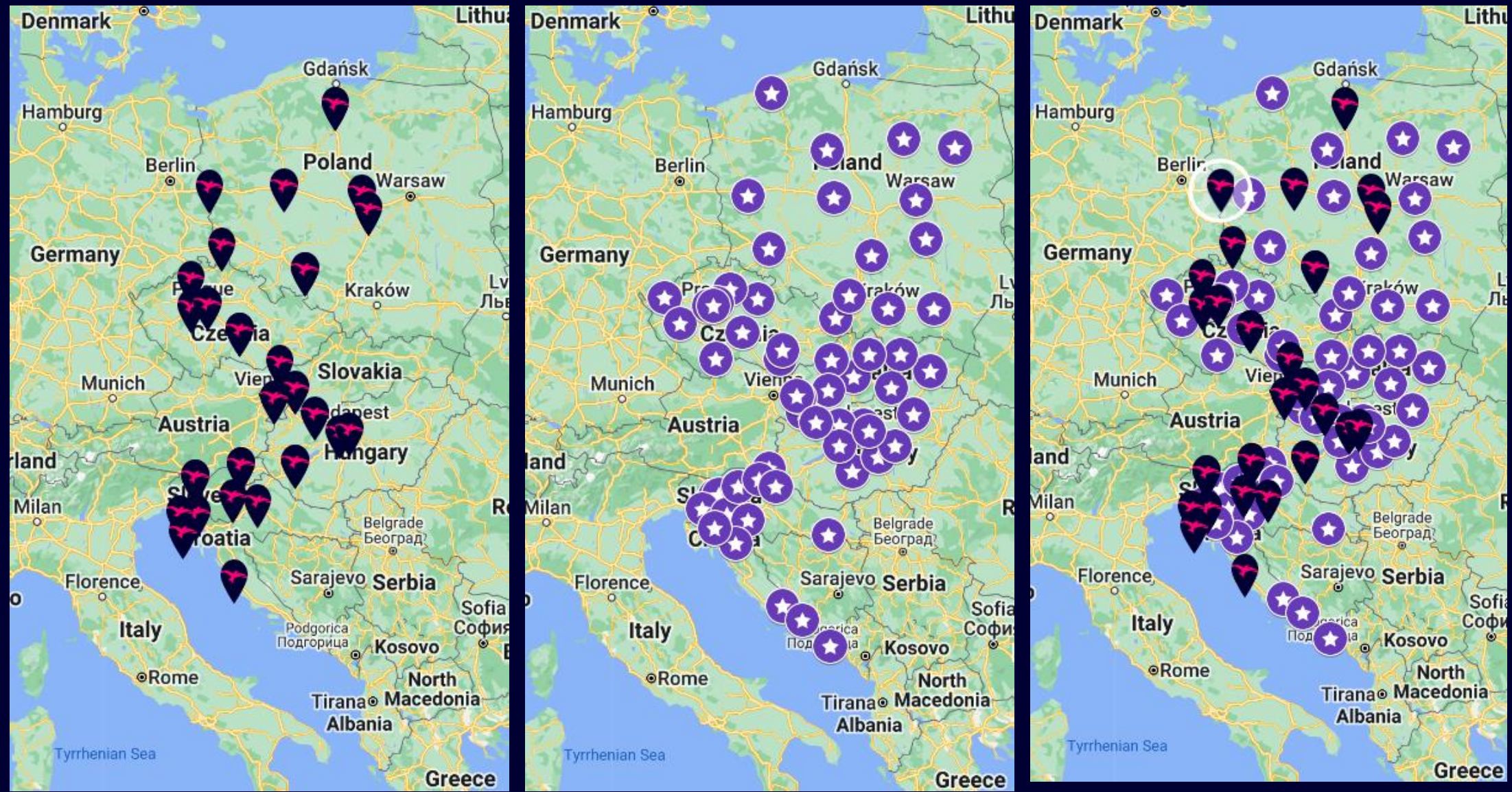

EU FUNDING FOR EV CHARGING

CONNECTING EUROPE FACILITY (2014-2021)

Established in 2014

EU fund for infrastructure investments across the union in transport, energy, digital and telecommunication projects with the aim for greater connectivity between EU member states.

Funding mechanism: 20% of eligible CAPEX cost

EUROP-E (CEF)



Timeframe:	2017 – 2024
EU Grant:	39 M€
Funding rate:	20% of CAPEX
Consortium Partners:	BMW, Ford, Mercedes-Benz, Volkswagen
Associated Partners:	Porsche, Digital Charging Solutions
Scope:	installing 340 charging sites across 13 EU Member States: AT, BE, DK, FR, DE, IE, IT, NL, PL, PT, ES, SE, UK EV manufacturer to integrate the IONITY Network in the Vehicles and enable Plug & Charge

EU FUNDING FOR EV CHARGING

CONNECTING EUROPE FACILITY (2021-2027)

Alternative Fuels Infrastructure Facility (AFIF)

established in 2021 (under CEF)

to support the deployment of alternative fuel supply infrastructure, contributing to decarbonising transport along the TEN-T network

Funding mechanism: unit contribution per installed charging point (between 20 and 60 k€, depending on charging point – e.g. Truck Charging receives higher amount)

AFIF is closed, last call for projects was until 7. November 2023

EXPAND-E (CEF2) 

Timeframe:	2023 – 2025
EU Grant:	70 M€
Funding rate:	unit contribution per installed charging point
Consortium Partners:	GreenWay, K Auto, Renovatio, Fortisis, Grid Telecom (Co-Coordinator)
Scope:	installing 461 charging sites across 23 EU Member States: AT, BE, DE, DK, EE, ES, FI, FR, IE, IT, NL, PT, SE, CZ, GR, HU, HR, LT, LV, PL, RO, SK, SL Each CPO to build their own Network, ensuring EU coverage
